#### INTERNET

Visit [www.dmvNOW.com](http://www.dmvNOW.com) and explore the 25 different transactions that can be conducted online. Renew your vehicle registration online, avoid the \$5 in-person fee and receive a \$1 discount. Change your address, renew your driver's license, buy a personalized plate and conduct many other transactions online.

#### TELEPHONE

With the touch of a few buttons, you can use DMV's telephone service to conduct your routine transactions. Avoid the additional \$5 fee for in-person vehicle registration renewals. Use the touchtone service at **1-888-337-4782.**

#### MAIL

Mail your vehicle registration renewals to avoid a \$5 fee for in-person service. Driver's license renewals can also be mailed.

#### DMV Select

Fifty DMV Select offices throughout Virginia provide you with a convenient alternative to a full-service DMV customer service center. The \$5 fee for in-person vehicle registration renewals does not apply at DMV Selects. Visit [www.dmvNOW.com](http://www.dmvNOW.com) for locations.
